Hunter, a Dallas native, is an award-winning documentary filmmaker and television producer who has produced more than a dozen documentaries for network and cable television networks.

Among his award-winning documentaries are "Black Wheels," "The Lessons of Hayti," and "Universal Babe."

Byron has worked on documentary projects in partnership with organizations that include the NBA, WNBA, MLB, NASCAR, the PGA of America, FIBA and the New York Yankees. His work has been aired on ABC, NBC, FOX, ESPN, DIRECT TV, BET, and Speed Channel.

One of his most recent films, "Santos Vive," about the 1973 murder of 12-year old Santos Rodriguez, has been influential in the honoring of Santos Rodriguez by the City of Dallas more than 46 years after his murder.
